Ashburton Airfield

Our airfield is outside is an Uncontrolled Airfield.

Good airmanship requires: A standard overhead join. All circuits left hand. Maintain a good lookout. Remember your R/T calls are not enough. There will be Nordo traffic. There will not be any parachutists operating from the airfield.

Accommodation

You are responsible for making your own bookings. If you wish to camp on field (not actually a camping ground!) we have a suitable area and or building. Showers and toilets available. Breakfast and all meals available on field.

Transport to Ashburton

Over the period of the Fly-In there will be a shuttle van available at suitable times either to take you into town or to bring you out again, a *GOLD COIN* donation please.
